Dear Naomi,

We the living men and women of Operation Good Oil, representing the living men and women of New Zealand, Aotearoa do hereby deliver this formal written notice of our demands to the Board and Management of Channel Infrastructure NZ Limited.

We order you to fulfill your fiduciary duty to the people of New Zealand with respect to the operation of the refinery plant that was built specifically as critical infrastructure in a joint venture between the New Zealand Public and Oil Companies to mitigate the risk of price shocks and/or supply issues of petroleum based fuels and ancillary products.

Therefore our demand is the refining capacity at Marsden Point be restored to service forth with in preparation for a return to refining petroleum products as soon as a supply of crude can be arranged and contracts to supply can be established.

Failure to comply with this demand will result in lawful challenges being brought against Channel Infrastructure NZ Limited, the members of the board of directors both past and present involved in bringing about the shutdown of refinery operations, yourself as chief executive, the chief financial officer, and all others involved in framing the business case for shutting down the plant used to refine petroleum crude into fuel and other products.
